

BARRETTINE PEELAWAY 1 NEUTRALISER

The Peelaway Neutraliser is a concentrated liquid compound that will neutralise alkaline residues that are left on the surface after being stripped by the Peelaway 1 product.

DO NOT USE FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

CONCENTRATE:

1 litre concentrate makes 2 litres of neutraliser. Coverage is approximately 5m² per litre.

1. Mix one part Neutraliser with one part water. Pour water into an empty bucket then carefully add an equal amount of Peelaway Neutraliser.

FOR PLASTER SURFACES: Dilute four parts water to one part Peelaway Neutraliser.

2. Pour diluted neutraliser into a garden type pressure sprayer or for smaller areas a hand held trigger sprayer. The stripped surface must be clean before starting the neutralisation process. Start at the top and spray the entire surface until saturated. Do not apply to the surface in any other way than spraying as you may contaminate the neutraliser.

3. Allow the neutraliser to remain on the surface until touch dry, but not less than six hours. Neutralising effectiveness is maximised by scrubbing surface once the neutraliser has been sprayed on.

DO NOT SCRUB PLASTER OR GESSO.

4. Rinse surface with a steady spray of clean water. For external use apply sensible water pressure, enough to thoroughly rinse but not damage the surface.

5. Test pH level of surface with pH paper. Most accurate testing is accomplished when the surface has been allowed to air dry a minimum of 24 hours after the neutralising process.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE pH TESTING PAPERS INCLUDED WITH PEELAWAY 1.

Moisten surface with water and apply a small strip of pH paper to the surface and note colour change and compare with pH charts on the inside of the covers of the pH papers. Any surface with pH of more than 8 should be re-neutralised and left to dry thoroughly before testing.

Health, Safety & Environmental Information

Causes serious eye irritation.
