DIRECTIONS OF USE:

- For best results build charcoal or briquettes into a pyramid.
- Apply fluid liberally onto charcoal
- Use long matches or taper to ignite fluid.
- Never add lighting fluid onto hot or burning coals.
- Once barbecue is alight add more charcoal as required.
- Before commencing cooking wait for charcoal to take on a grey ash appearance.
- Never leave a hot barbecue unattended.

TO AVOID RISK OF SPILLAGE ALWAYS ENSURE THE CAP IS SCREWED DOWN TIGHTLY AND CONTAINER IS SECURED UPRIGHT DURING TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE.
