Recommend treating with Barrettine All-in-One and + 25°C. Decking Oil or micro porous finish (ideally 2 coats, all sides) and leave to dry for 24 - 48 hours. N.B. New wood should be first wiped down with white spirit to remove surface resins etc. Highly resinous timbers and some hardwoods may effect performance and final results. The surface is then prepared and ready for Anti-Slip Top Coat Decking Oil.

Preparation of insitu / existing wood:

Ensure all surfaces are clean, dry and free from dust, dirt and algae. Old paints and lacquers must be completely removed. Treat with a mould and mildew cleaner if necessary. Treat with a decking oil or microporous finish (1-2 coats) and leave to dry for 24 - 48 hours before applying Anti-Slip Top Coat Decking Oil.

PRODUCT APPLICATION

Shake well before use and stir during use. Decant into a paint kettle and apply an even coat to required surfaces to ensure optimum performance, finally brushing in the direction of wood grain.
