Traditional Floor Wax is a translucent, easily applied wax finish which revives and refreshes wood floors. It gives a gentle sheen to naturally enhance the beauty of wood, whilst reducing the appearance of micro scratches. Traditional Floor Wax is easy to apply and can be applied on previously treated surfaces to maintain or improve the existing patina.

PREPARATION

Before use, test a small inconspicuous area with all products to be used, to ensure a satisfactory final finish and compatibility.

Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as chemical resistant gloves, overalls and eye/face protection to protect against splashes. If in doubt speak, to your PPE supplier and show them this label/product, or call us for further advice. Not recommended on untreated wood floors. For protection against scratch and water resistance, we recommend first sealing the wood with Polyurethane Varnish or Quick Drying Floor Varnish. For maintenance of coated floors, vacuum or sweep away any loose debris and wipe the floor with a lightly dampened mop if required.

APPLICATION

Take a clean, lint-free cloth and lightly apply in the direction of the wood grain where possible. Allow to dry then buff away any excess using another clean, lint-free cloth.

Best results are achieved when the floor wax is applied sparingly and worked into small areas at a time. Buff floor to desired sheen level by hand or using a mechanical polisher. Over-spill can be cleaned using white spirit.
